I am requesting funding for the Greenway Connector Project in Fiscal Year 2027. The entity to receive funding for this project is the City of Tucker, GA located at 1975 Lakeside Parkway, Suite 350A, Tucker, GA 30084.

The funding would be used for right-of-way acquisition and construction of the Tucker Greenway Connector, a project that advances a long-planned community priority and is backed by significant local investment, including City matching funds and SPLOST funding. The purpose of the project is to close critical gaps in pedestrian and bicycle infrastructure, creating safe and affordable transportation options while improving access to jobs, parks, schools, and businesses.
