I am requesting funding for the Gwinnett County Accessible Pedestrian Signal Upgrade in Fiscal Year 2027. The entity to receive funding for this project is the Gwinnett County Board of Commissioners, located at 75 Langley Drive, Lawrenceville, GA 30046.

The funding would be used to upgrade signalized intersections near schools, parks, and other high-pedestrian areas to meet new Public Right-of-Way Accessibility Guidelines standards, improving safety and accessibility for children, families, seniors, and individuals with disabilities. By making these crossings safer and more navigable, the project strengthens access to education, recreation, and essential community spaces while reducing crash risks in places where people walk most often. This is a valuable use of taxpayer funds because it invests in federally compliant infrastructure that protects public safety, expands mobility, and supports healthier, more connected communities across Georgia.

The project has a federal nexus because the funding provided is for purposes authorized by 42 U.S.C. 5305(a)(2).
