I am requesting funding for a project to Increase Pedestrian and Vehicular Safety via the Realignment of Chestnut Drive at Buford Highway in fiscal year 2024. The entity to receive funding for this project is the City of Doraville, located at 3725 Park Avenue, Doraville, Georgia 30340.
